Change LogDefinitions



Change Type	Description
Bug Fix	A correction of an error or issue in the document or system that was causing incorrect behavior, malfunctions, or undesirable results.
Translation	Updates made to support additional languages, regions
Feature addition/ removal	A change that adds a completely new functionality or capability to the document or system. OR: A change that removes or marks a feature as outdated and no longer supported.
Content update	Changes made purely to the content, such as updating information, or enhancing clarity.
Minor Update	Smaller changes or improvements, e.g. added functionality
New Release / Major Update	A significant change that typically introduces new content. New release of pathways.
